

**NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS,
POLLING PLACES AND POLLING STATIONS**

Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places in accordance with the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended by the Electoral Administration Act 2006).

The Returning Officer for Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council will make comments on existing arrangements and suggested amendments.

In addition, representations are invited from other relevant sources such as the electors within the Staffordshire Parliamentary constituencies, elected members, local political parties and organisations that have expertise in relation to access to premises for people with different forms of disability. (Persons or bodies making representations about specific polling station venues should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places).

This consultation period will commence on 18 December 2017 and needs to be completed in sufficient time to enable the Elections Office to make any alterations necessary to the register of electors. Therefore, all comments should be received by 26 January, 2018.
