1. A By-Election will be held for one Councillor to serve the Holditch & Chesterton Ward.
2. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Castle House, Barracks Road, Newcastle-under-Lyme, Staffordshire, ST5 1BL on any working day after the date of this notice, Monday to Friday 9.30am to 4pm (excluding bank holidays), but no later than 4pm on Friday, 22 February 2019.
3. Nomination papers may be obtained from the offices of the Returning Officer, Castle House, Barracks Road, Newcastle-under-Lyme, Staffordshire, ST5 1BL during the times stated above.
4. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 21 March 2019.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday, 5 March 2019. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
6. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Castle House, Barracks Road, Newcastle-under-Lyme, Staffordshire, ST5 1BL by 5pm on Wednesday, 6 March 2019.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Castle House, Barracks Road, Newcastle-under-Lyme, Staffordshire, ST5 1BL by 5pm on Wednesday, 13 March 2019.
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Castle House, Barracks Road, Newcastle-under-Lyme, Staffordshire, ST5 1BL by 5pm on Thursday, 21 March 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 13 March 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 13 March 2019.
